To: Parents/Guardians in the Vibank and Sedley Attendance Areas:

This letter is in follow up to my February 2016 letter to you regarding a review of the Sedley and Vibank Attendance Areas. As explained at that time, the Vibank and Sedley School Attendance Areas were reviewed in September 2012 as part of a Division-wide review of transportation services. In response to recent feedback from some families, these areas were again reviewed this spring.

Public input and feedback is an important part of the review process, therefore local stakeholders received a copy of maps with the current boundaries, the proposed boundaries and a feedback form. I also committed that all input would be reviewed and considered prior to finalizing the boundaries.

The review process is now complete and the Sedley and Vibank Attendance Areas will remain unchanged. We have thoroughly reviewed all information and in the final analysis, the proposed boundary change was determined to have a potential negative impact on the Sedley Attendance Area. Therefore, the decision of the school division is to maintain the current attendance areas.

This means that transportation arrangements will remain unchanged at this time. Courtesy riding options will continue to be available to out of attendance area students consistent with the Division-wide policy and practice.

Thank you for your input and suggestions during this review, we very much appreciate your participation.
