CLASSES BEGIN TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 7TH, 2010

Students in Prairie Valley School Division are back to class on Tuesday, September 7th at all 38 schools across the Division.

September 7th will also be proclaimed province-wide as Provincial Students' Day by the Minister of Education. The proclamation is in response to action taken on a resolution passed by the Saskatchewan School Boards Association membership at the December 2009 Annual General Meeting.

"Prairie Valley is unique in that students are resuming classes after Labour Day, and on Provincial Students' Day. We welcome back all new and returning students. Schools are all about students, and I know our schools will be a welcoming place for everyone in the 2010-2011 school year," said Director of Education Ben Grebinski.

Students are coming back to refreshed and renovated facilities, innovative and enhanced programming, as well as new equipment in math, science, physical education and practical and applied arts. The post-Labour Day start is part of the 310 minute calendar that students will be following again this school year in Prairie Valley.
