

A Message from the Prairie Valley Board of Education

On behalf of the Prairie Valley Board of Education, I am proud to report that in 2017-2018, students in the Prairie Valley School Division achieved some the Division's best results to-date, and for that, we are celebrating.

In December, the Board released the *2017-2018 Community Report*, closing off last school year and wrapping up the first year of the *2017-2021 Strategic Plan*. Results show student achievement in reading, literacy, math and graduation grew and that students in this division are achieving academic success.

Highlights from the year include:

- Student academic achievement is at an all-time high.
- Students are graduating at a rate 10 percentage points higher than the provincial average.
- Continued high attendance rates.
- Reading and math scores remain strong.
- Strong emergency response protocols are in place.
- Transportation is safe and reliable and support services remained strong.
- Continued, strong expenditure management.

While Prairie Valley staff, Board, students, community members and you, parents and guardians, should be very proud of the system performance results, I hope you are all equally as proud of the Division's progress in continuing to grow an inclusive, caring and kind school division.

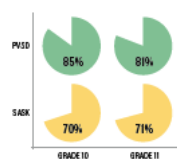

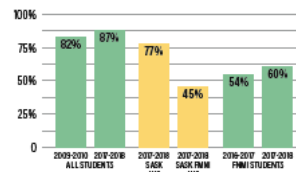
Student Academic Achievement
